## Premier's Award for Excellence 2019 – Conditions of Entry

As an exhibitor in this year's Tasmanian Craft Fair you are eligible to enter the Tasmanian Craft Fair's major award, the Premier's Award for Excellence.

This is one of the most valuable awards in Australia for the craft arts.

Previous winners have included ceramic and glass vases, a machine embroidered bird, a porcelain teapot set, silver cups, fine wood sculpture and fine jewellery.

### Conditions of Entry:

1. An entrant must be an exhibitor in the 2019 Tasmanian Craft Fair.
2. The Award is acquisitive.
3. The Award is for the best new piece of work (the "piece"). The piece must be less than one year old and not previously exhibited at another show or exhibition.
4. The piece must be the original work and concept of the entrant.
5. The piece may be made using any medium, including silver, textiles, painting, sculpture, glass, ceramics, paper etc.
6. Exhibitors may enter a maximum of **2** pieces in the Award. A **separate** entry form and \$30 entry fee is required for each piece entered.
7. Applications will be received until 30 September 2019.
8. Entrants are requested to submit up to three (3) images of "the piece" being entered. Photographs should be emailed at a resolution of at least 300dpi to the Secretary by 30 September. It is acceptable for the piece to vary slightly from the submitted images if you are working on the piece until nearer the time of the Craft Fair, however the piece may not be substituted without prior agreement with the Craft Fair Director.
9. If posting the entry, printed photographs of the piece may be supplied. Three (3) copies of each are required (one for each judge) to enable the judges to gain an impression before judging commences. The back of each photograph should be labelled with the entrant's name, trading name, medium, size and title of piece. All photographs will be retained.
10. A non-refundable fee of \$30.00 is payable on receipt of invoice, with due date as stated on the invoice. Please pay by bank transfer with a reference to the invoice number. Alternatively, enclose a cheque with your posted application.
11. Each piece must be prominently displayed at the entrant's stall for the period of the Craft Fair.
12. Each piece entered, except for the winning entry, is to be available for purchase by the public, but a buyer can only collect any piece which was entered in the Award at the conclusion of the Tasmanian Craft Fair.
13. The winner will be announced at the Awards Ceremony on Saturday evening, 2 November 2019.

14. Tickets for the Awards Dinner must be purchased separately.
15. Submission of an entry constitutes the entrant's acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.
16. The judges' decision is final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.
17. Past winners of the Award are not eligible to enter the Award in the year immediately after their win.

**NOTE:** Other awards presented at the Tasmanian Craft Fair 2019 include:

- Best Working Exhibit
- Stand Presentation
- First Time Exhibitor
- Providore Exhibitor

These awards will be judged throughout the duration of the Tasmanian Craft Fair.
